

The General Management of JV&H focuses on the SGI as a way to organize the operation of the organization based on basic pillars such as the Quality and Safety of its products, customer satisfaction and commitment to the continuous improvement of the SGI. To this end, JV&H's SGI is based on the following commitments:

- The improvement of quality and the management of food safety are the responsibility of all members of JV&H starting from senior management.
- Food quality and safety is obtained by planning, executing, reviewing, and improving the Management System, always keeping in mind the purpose and context of the organization, both internal and external.
- The SGI is oriented towards the satisfaction of all our customers (and stakeholders), through the commitment of the entire organization to meet their mutually agreed needs and requirements, as well as the legal, regulatory and product requirements.
- The IMS is based on the Continuous Improvement of both the production processes and the provision of the service, as well as the effectiveness of the IMS in which preventing errors is a fundamental aspect.
- Train and sensitize the staff of the organization for the correct development of all the activities carried out, especially in the handling of food, carrying out Good Practices in terms of Food Safety.
- The IMS requires the need to address the training, competence, participation, and collaboration of all employees so this Policy is disseminated to all staff of the organization for their knowledge and understanding.
- Promoting internal and external communication as the guiding axis of our Management System
- Maintain the facilities in a safe hygienic state, in accordance with the applicable regulations.

This policy is also intended to provide a frame of reference for the setting of the objectives of the IMS. In addition, for the effective application of these principles, it is absolutely necessary to support the same both of the management and of all the employees of the organization.
